If you're finding that your child is struggling with reading you may want to try one or more of these tips.

Evaluate: What is your opinion about the story or information you just read?

- Is the information facts or the author's opinion?
- What are some facts you learned in the book or what is your opinion of the book.

Imagery: What images appear in your mind as you read?

Visualizing: picture what you read in your mind. How would the setting and the characters look if you could see them?

Last Month's Tips:

Purpose: Are you reading to find out what happens in a story or to find out information.

Author's purpose is to persuade, inform or entertain.

Connect: How is the story or information similar to what you know?
